BE A PART OF THE JEFFERSONTOWN HIGH SCHOOL MEMORY WALK!!

With the events of wind and ice storms last year, the signs to the entrance of the Jeffersontown High School football field were destroyed. Since the football complex has had few updates since its original construction, it has become obvious that we need a "new look." It is time for those chain link fences to be replaced with stone and our school's name displayed with a more permanent metal lettering! It is time that the unremarkable concrete walkway from the parking lot to the football field is replaced!

The Jeffersontown High School Alumni Association is designing a new "Memory Walk" as part of the new look for our football field. The walkway will be engraved with the names of those Chargers who have passed through those gates. Whether you were a football player, cheerleader, band member, soccer player, or simply a fan, this field was a place that created memories. And it is the place where you can leave your name for all to see!

You can be a part of the Memory Walk by purchasing a "Memory Brick" for the walkway. 
If desired, Choose from these available symbols
