## A CHARGER'S RUN FOR THE ROSES

Ron Frey, Jeffersontown High School class of 1977, realized a dream that only a few can only imagine --- he owned a horse running in the Kentucky Derby!

So what is it like to be part owner of a Derby horse?

Absolutely amazing! I have followed horse racing for 25 years and would always daydream of owning a horse that ran in the Kentucky Derby. I would picture him coming down the stretch and winning the most famous horse race in the world. And now that dream has come true; almost anyway--- he just didn't win. But being a part of something that very few in the world will ever have a chance to take part in, is incredible, to say the least.

I actually got into the Chasing Dreams Stable with 23 other people whom I had never met. A year and a half ago my secretary asked if I was interested in buying a share in a horse partnership that her son was in. Without hesitation, I said yes! And the rest is history!

Noble's Promise's first race was in April, 2009, at Keeneland. He finished second. All of us in the partnership knew we had a good horse, but at that point, we had no idea that he had Derby potential. He won his second race at Ellis Park and three weeks later he won a stakes race in Erie, Pennsylvania. But in October of last year, he won a \$500,000 race at Keeneland, and the winner's circle was pure pandemonium with well over 100 friends and family there to celebrate. Along with the excitement of winning a race of this magnitude, who do we see in the winner's circle with us? Charlize Theron, who was a guest of the sponsor of the race! Wow!

Noble's Promise ran his next race four weeks later in the Breeder's Cup in California

to get third, followed by three more races before the Kentucky Derby.

The whole week of Derby week was filled with excitement. I drove from Lexington to Louisville every day to take part in the experience of being a Derby horse owner. On Monday all of the partners watched Noble's final workout to decide if he was going to run. When the trainer said he was ready, we laughed and hugged with excitement!

On Tuesday NBC Sports filmed and interviewed our partnership. On Wednesday we all got to attend the Derby post position draw, and that Thursday ESPN filmed and interviewed our group. On Derby day I was able to walk from the barn to the paddock with Noble's Promise just before the race. Wow! What an experience to be in front of 150,000 people and on national television with millions of horse racing fans cheering us on! Unbelievable! Something I'll never forget!



When the race began and Noble's Promise was in the lead at the top of the stretch, I thought, OH MY GOD! HE MIGHT WIN! But as we all know, he finished 5th. But every one of the partners is extremely proud of his amazing effort.

The excitement continues as Noble's Promise is now scheduled to run his next race at The Royal Ascot in England on June 15th. This prestigious European race is much like our Derby. Most of the partners, including myself, will attend which could produce a meeting with the Queen of England who favors introductions to the horse owners. If Noble's Promise wins this race, he will be established as an international horse and will increase his breeding career.

So far this has been the most exciting adventure in my life! And there's still much more to go as he will race the rest of this year and next year as a four year old. This awesome ride has been an adventure that I will never forget! To be a part of something you used to only dream about, but has now come true, is amazing to say the least!

## JHS ALUM RUNS FOR MAYOR OF LOUISVILLE

When Jonathan Robertson, class of 1983, announced he was running for Mayor of Louisville, his mother's first reaction was trepidation. "She was afraid of what I was going to say," recalls Robertson. "But when she saw I was serious about this, she said she was very proud of me and jumped on board."



Robertson, who grew up in Jeffersontown and still lives off Easum Road with his wife Jenise and his two children, Alex (15) and Jacklyn (13), decided to run for Mayor when he noticed himself complaining about the management of Louisville and not doing anything about it. The resignation of longtime Louisville Mayor, Jerry Abramson, presented an opportunity too good for Robertson to pass.

"The race is wide open this year and I saw this is my chance. I've always had a burning desire to be in politics."

Upon hearing of Robertson's endeavor, people immediately question his lack of experience in the political arena.

"That's exactly why I am running, " Robertson said excitedly. "Because I don't have any experience. I have a desire to do what's right for this city."

One area Robertson does have experience in is information technology. He currently runs his own business, Dynamiq, where he creates networking systems and other technical needs for clients. So it's no surprise that he talks about technology often in candidate forums around the city. He believes the city can easily save 10-15% utilizing today's technology. Even though technology is Robertson's "niche", he is ready to talk about any of the issues.

"When I'm standing in line at Starbucks I'll introduce myself to the person behind me. Some people thought I was running just to draw attention to myself," laughs Robertson.

In fact, JHS Alum Traci Roederer Tyler ('84) ran into Robertson at the bank while purchasing Derby pins and a conversation ensued between the two regarding Robertson's future in politics.

"Jonathan is a smart guy. If he doesn't know the answer to a question, he will find the person who knows the answer regardless of their (political) party," says Traci.

Throwing your name in the proverbial campaign hat for City of Louisville is no joke and Robertson is taking it seriously despite his lack of exposure. You may not have seen Robertson's commercials on TV or heard his radio commercials with the catchy jingles -- that's because he doesn't have any.

"I raised less than \$1,000 for this campaign on purpose," explains Robertson portraying himself as every person's candidate. "A lot of races are bought in this country with splashy TV ads and I didn't want to be like that. Plus, it's a bad economy and I didn't feel right asking people for money. His family forced him to take some donations and he has used the money mostly to buy signs."

JHS Alumni who graduated in the 1980's may remember Robertson's foray into politics. In an unprecedented event in school history, Robertson and 5 others ran on the same ticket as one for class president his senior year. They were called "The Big Six." The idea started when three friends were running against each other for Senior Class President and realized they would be more effective if they ran as one instead of one person winning the candidacy and the other two sitting out. Recalling those days, Jonathan is quick to credit fellow running mate Diana Ellingsworth for doing all the work. When contacted via email, Ellingsworth also was complimentary of her fellow classmate.

"I believe that Jonathan is a man of good moral character who truly cares about Louisville's future. . . for his children and his community. He is not afraid to work hard or work smart - he will serve his Community well! Go Jonathan!", writes Diana Ellingsworth Russell, who now lives in Ohio.

Robertson also played soccer and participated in the plays at JHS.

"I was in the Solid Gold plays during Ms. Rose's era." Robertson enjoyed those days explaining that the castmates of the plays worked long hours while juggling homework to accomplish a goal.

One thing Robertson says he will take away from this race is the fact that he is no different than the other candidates despite their popularity and large campaign funds.

"The other candidates are no different from me. They loose sleep before a forum just like me...they get nervous at these forums just like me. I just want to make a difference. I'll be disappointed if I've tried this and all I get is a 1,000 votes." Robertson says with a smile.


